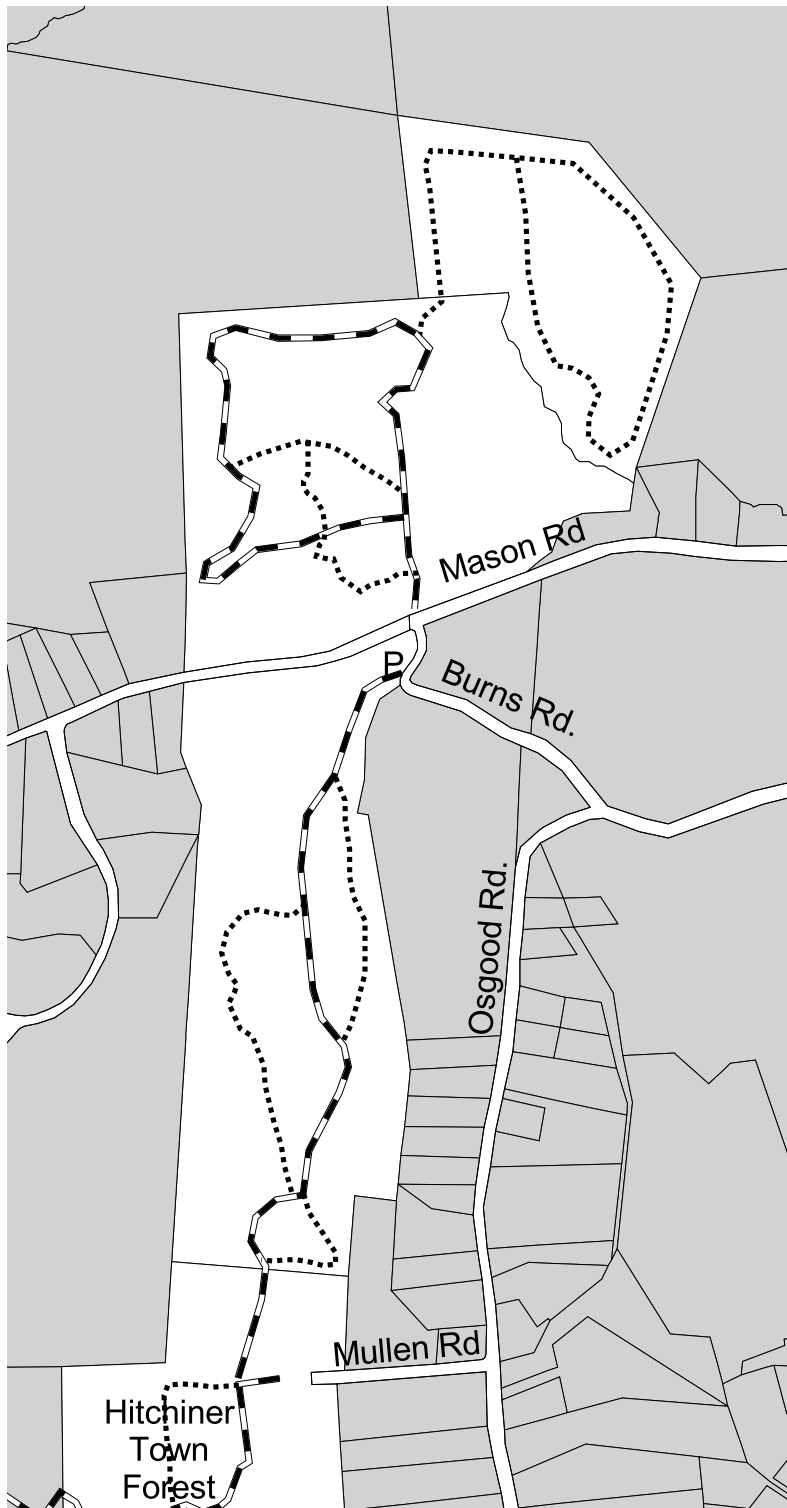






Beaver Brook Association's Burns Farm Trails
